PA Act 101 requires recycling in commercial and institutional establishments in communities with a population of 5,000 or more.

City Ordinance requires businesses and institutions to report recycled totals each year.

SO MUCH PAPER TO RECYCLE

Check with your City Recycling Coordinator to see if they can be recycled together or should be kept separate.

NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES, CATALOGS, & PHONEBOOKS

Place these items in your plastic red recycling bin.

OFFICE PAPER

Computer paper, envelopes and unwanted mail.

CARDBOARD BOXES

Heavy shipping boxes, light weight boxes, and pizza boxes.

Please **FLATTEN** boxes.



HOW TO PREPARE RECYCLABLES

1. *Remove food and drink waste from containers by a quick rinse.*
2. *Discard liners from boxes.*
3. *Put shredded paper in a clear plastic bag.*
4. *Flattening plastic bottles and leaving caps off will make more room.*

Please do not place broken glass in the recycling bin.

HELPFUL TIP:

Plastic grocery or store bags cannot be put in your recycling bin. Please return them to the grocery store or even better purchase and use reusable bags.

COMINGLE CONTAINERS CANS, BOTTLES & JARS

GLASS

Bottles & Jars only!

The tops should be thrown away.

- NO windows, mugs or glasses etc.

CANS

Aluminum & Steel (Tin)

Beverage & Food containers

PLASTIC

Bottles, jars, milk, soda, water & soaps

- NO cups, toys, plant pots etc.

- NO styrofoam & deli containers

- NO PLASTIC BAGS



THE FOLLOWING CANNOT BE RECYCLED:

Food wrappers, paper or foam dishes/cups, snack bags, straws, utensils, wraps and film.
