MR. WEINBERGER: My name is Jerry Wienberger and I'm representing the Penn Security Bank. The purpose of the Murphy Court expansion is to allow for the development of a branch bank on a vacant lot on Davis Street in Birney Avenue and Murphy Court in order to accommodate the auto traffic and safety vehicles needs to be widened to 22 feet. This has already passed by the City Planning Commission and we are asking council to allow us to simultaneously vacate the old ordinance, which is very irregular in shape, and adopt an ordinance creating a new Murphy Court, which is more regularly shaped, and there is no cost to the city. The purchaser of the bank will bear all of the costs for the reconstruction of the Court.

MS. EVANS: Thank you. Is there anyone else who cares to address council?

MR. PASCALE: We are on the agenda,

I think, for a public hearing. I don't know 1 if now is the time to address it? 2 3 MS. EVANS: This public hearing concerns Murphy Court. 4 5 MR. PASCALE: Okay. MS. EVANS: Mr. Loscombe? 6 7 MR. LOSCOMBE: Yes, I just wanted 8 to, you know, last week I did state that I 9 had gone around to the neighbors and they are all in favor of this project and I did 10 visit the site, and you are right it is an 11 12 irregular setup there, so I think it's going 13 to be a benefit for everybody and, you know, 14 I definitely am in favor of it.
