consider that property as a possibility to

buying it with the funds that are available.

It's in excellent condition, brand new furnace, year old. It's in a nice neighborhood, schools, convenient, bus route right at the corner. And it could be a two-bedroom downstairs, single upstairs.

But we have single people, couples, low, moderate incomes that are in need of housing, decent housing in our area. I have the listing information. Can I present this to someone?

MR. PERRY: Sure. You can leave it with Kathy right there.

MS. MANSOUR: It's listed with a

1 realtor. So if you could kindly consider that I would appreciate it, not only for myself but 2 3 for the benefit of the people who are in need. 4 Thank you. 5 MR. PERRY: And is there a contact number on that information as well if we need 6 7 to get --8 MS. MANSOUR: For the realtor, yes. 9 MR. PERRY: Okay. 10 MS. MANSOUR: Deal directly with the 11 realtor. Thank you. 12 MR. PERRY: Okay. Thank you. 13 the next name on the sheet is Ron Ellman. 14 MR. ELLMAN: Yes, gentlemen, I just 15 got a quick question. Maybe two weeks ago I've 16 been fighting with my insurance company 17 Hartford. They don't come no worse than these people, let me tell you. 18 19 I was complaining about something 20 and they sent me a letter back saying -- I'm 21 not exactly -- I think they said it cost \$117 a 22 square foot if my house burned down to rebuild 23 And you're talking about --MR. PERRY: Mr. Ellman, does this 24 25 have to do with the public hearing?

MR. ELLMAN: You're talking about a \$127,000 you want to build a duplex and refurnish two other houses. That's impossible. And I'm not against the idea. But that's no money. You know, how are you going to do it? I wish you could tell Hartford how to do it. Am I wrong? Why don't you just talk about one little single house or something and I don't think you can do it.

My roof cost \$7,000 a couple years ago. And now they said that's a bargain. I don't know. All you people, you just think of things in the wrong way to me. Thank you.

MR. PERRY: Thank you. That's all the names on the sign-in sheet. Is there anybody else that would like to talk during this public hearing?

MS. SCHUMACHER: Marie Schumacher, I have no opposition to the switching of the funding. But I would definitely not want new housing built. We have enough empty structures in this City that we could -- that they should be used.

And a lot of elderly people are going out looking for jobs just based on what

the school board is doing this year -- this coming year and the succeeding several years.

And I think that would sort of be a slap in the face that you're going to give probably somebody that comes into the -- in here and give them a brand new house. And plus as I say, the main reason though is all the vacancies we have. So I think that should be primary. Thank you.
