# **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1.) Review of Land Development Plan by May Associates, LLP for construction of new Dunkin Donuts with drive-thru at Mulberry Street and Mifflin Avenue (former Sunoco) C-D Zone.

George Albert, G & Albert Consultants, representing May Associates LLP. The City Engineer's comments have been addressed. Zoning Hearing Board approved the variance. May Associates has received approval from the Conservation District, but still waiting for the letter. Lackawanna County Regional Planning Commission has given approval. PennDOT is processing

the HOP. The tanks should be removed by the end of the month. The project will be started in July.

Brian Swanson stated his comments have been addressed. Mr. King recommended conditional approval, with the following conditions:

- Soil Conservation District Approval;
- Highway Occupancy Permit (HOP) obtained.

A motion to grand conditional approval with the above-mentioned conditions was made by Mr. Jones and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Preambo. Approved 4-0.

2.) Review of Subdivision Plan by 500 Lackawanna Development Co., to consolidate lots in the 500 blk of Lackawanna Ave, C-D Zone.

3.) Review of Subdivision Plan by William Jordan to consolidate lots in the 800 block of Beech St, R-1A Zone.

Mr. Bob Mendola, Surveyor, representing Mr. Jordan.

Mr. Jordan would like to consolidate two lots into one, making the lot  $55 \times 150$ , now they are  $27.5 \times 150$  each.

Brian Swanson stated he recommended approval. Mr. King recommends conditional approval with the following:

- Final review by the City Engineer.
