The City of Scranton Reminds Residents of COVID-19 Considerations for Halloween

SCRANTON - The City continues to monitor the CDC's COVID guidance around Halloween. Currently the CDC advises that "one-way trick-or-treating" in which "individually wrapped goodie bags are lined up for families to grab and go while continuing to social distance (such as at the end of a driveway or at the edge of a yard)" poses less risk than traditional trick-or-treating.

The Mayor has advised City departments to conduct any City-sponsored events in this manner, and asks community event sponsors and families to follow this "one-way trick-or-treating" guidance leading up to and on Halloween
