The City of Scranton's Office of Economic and Community Development (OECD) is currently taking applications for the **City of Scranton's Homebuyer Program**. This Program enables families who earn 80% or less of the median income established by HUD (see chart below) to purchase a single family home in the City of Scranton and make the American Dream a reality.

Scranton's Homebuyers Program is federally funded under the HOME Program since 1992 through the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The Homebuyers Program helps qualified buyers to purchase a single family home in Scranton by providing

- A subsidy of up to 1/2 of the down payment (maximum match dollar for dollar not to exceed \$7,000) or 10% of the purchase price of the home, whichever is less.
- Eligible closing costs up to \$5,000 maximum
- Total maximumamount is \$12,000.

The qualified buyers must be able to obtain a mortgage from a financial institution and attend Homebuyer Counseling classes. Some requirements include:

- Maximum purchase price
- Income limits
- Single family home must be located in the City of Scranton and be your principal residence. **Applicant's** cannot own any other property.
- Home must pass inspection to insure it meets Uniform Construction Code Standards at time of initial occupancy.
- A visual Lead Hazard Paint Assessment will be conducted at the time of the inspection.

In order to be eligible for financial assistance your total annual gross household income must not exceed the 80% income limits established by HUD for 2015.
