LINE PAINTING AND MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF TRAFFIC. THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER WILL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT CERTIFICATES OF INSURANCE, AS SPECIFIED, INCLUDING PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE. THE CONTRACT WILL BE AWARDED TO THE LOWEST MOST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER; HOWEVER, THE CITY OF SCRANTON RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS OR ANY PART OF ANY BID AND TO WAIVE ANY OR ALL INFORMALITIES IN THE BIDDING IN CONNECTION WITH SAID PROJECT. BIDDING SHALL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 603 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF THE CITY OF SCRANTON. THE CONTRACT, WHEN AWARDED, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE DAVIS BACON PREVAILING WAGE ACT. ALL WORK SHALL BE COMPLETED WITHIN 60 WORKING DAYS FOLLOWING THE NOTICE TO PROCEED WEATHER PERMITTING. THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER SHALL BE AN EQUAL OPPORTUNITY EMPLOYER.
